I, Hanuman Mal Choraria, (CP No. 1499, Membership No. FCS 2398) of M/s H. M. Choraria & Co., Practising Company Secretaries, have been appointed, by the Board of Directors of Bengal Tea & Fabrics Ltd [the Company] as a Scrutinizer for the purpose of conducting the Postal Ballot process, including voting through electronic means, in a fair and transparent manner in terms of the resolution in the Notice of Postal Ballot dated 29th July, 2017.

The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and Rules relating to Postal Ballot and voting through electronic means on the Resolution contained in the Notice dated 29th July, 2017. My responsibility as Scrutinizer for Postal Ballot, including evoting process, is restricted to make a Scrutinizer's Report of votes cast "In favour" or "Against" the resolution based on the Postal Ballots as provided by M/s C.B. Management Services Private Limited, Kolkata and reports generated from e-voting system provided by the Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL), the authorized agency engaged by the Company to provide the e-voting facility. This e-voting Report is generated on the basis of information available/downloaded from the CDSL website: www.evotingindia.com.

Further to the above, I hereby submit my Report:

- 1.1 The Company has completed dispatch of Notice of Postal Ballot dated 29th July, 2017 along with the Postal Ballot Forms with self addressed postage prepaid business reply envelopes to its members whose names appeared on the Register of Members/list of beneficiaries as on 04th August, 2017 (the cut-off date), on 9th August, 2017 through Registered Post/Speed Post/ electronic mode.
- 1.2 Particulars of all Postal Ballot Forms received from the members have been entered in a register separately maintained for the purpose.
- 1.3. The Postal Ballot Forms were kept under my safe custody in sealed and tamper proof ballot boxes before commencing the scrutiny of such Postal Ballot Forms.



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- 1.4. The ballot boxes were opened on 11th September, 2017 after 10.00 A.M. (IST), in my presence.
- 1.5. The Postal Ballot Forms were duly scrutinized in my presence on 11th September, 2017 and the shareholding was matched/confirmed with the Register of Members of the Company/list of beneficiaries.
- 1.6. All Postal Ballot Forms received on or before (6.00 P.M.) on 10th September, 2017, the last date and time fixed by the Company for receipt of the forms were considered for my scrutiny.
- 1.7. Envelopes containing Postal Ballot Form after 10th September, 2017, if any, were not considered for my scrutiny.
- 1.8. I did not find any defaced or mutilated Postal Ballot Form.
- 1.9. The e-voting period remained open from (09.00 A.M) IST on Saturday, 12th August, 2017 to Sunday, 10th September, 2017 up to (05.00 P.M.) IST.
- 1.10. As stated above, the e-voting period ended at 05.00 P.M. on 10th September, 2017. Thereafter, the votes cast via electronic means were unlocked by me in the presence of two witnesses Mr. Amit Choraria and Ms. Sunita Chakraborty, who are not in the employment of the Company. They have signed below in confirmation of the votes being unlocked in their presence. I have also received the complete records of votes cast by electronic mode from CDSL, the agency providing and supervising electronic platform-(EVSN-170801006) on 11th September, 2017.
